

- Minimal homework on weekends and no homework during school breaks (except Enhanced Math classes and ASL 1).
 - Academic break is a 3-day weekend or longer.



Textbooks




- All students have received their textbooks

- Students are responsible for the care of textbooks & will return them at the end of the school year. Please report damage or lost textbooks to the Library Media Center.






