Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to Venado Middle School, home of the Knights! We are proud of all that our school and staff have to offer and hope that you and your child's experiences over the next two years are rewarding and meaningful. Our office and administrative teams are working diligently to prepare for the next school year. A central part of this process is the registration process. Students will be placed in academic classes according to current placement, SBAC scores, IUSD Math placement criteria, EL status, etc. Some students may be placed in an intervention support class/lab. Parents/guardians will submit elective course requests online.

Parent Night - Thursday, April 18 (New Date!)

Our 6th Grade Parent Night for the parents of incoming 7th graders will be held on Thursday, April 18, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. Due to space limitations, this event is for parents only. This is a great opportunity for parents to meet staff and learn about Venado's programs, schedules, classes, etc. Limited parking is available for parents in our main parking lot at the front of the school. In addition, we obtained a parking variance from the City of Irvine, which allows parents to park on the school-side of Deerfield, starting at Doe Trail/Deer Creek and ending at Fawn Glenn/Deer Spring. If you live close to Venado, you may wish to consider walking. We look forward to seeing you there! Please do not use the Deerfield Elementary School parking lots, as they also have an event that evening.

6th Grade Student Assembly - Tuesday, April 23

On Tuesday, April 23, we will be hosting a special assembly for all incoming 7th graders. Due to space limitations, this assembly is for students and teachers only. Students will learn about their new school and classes, including electives, for next year. As Venado Knights, school spirit is a big part of student life on our campus. Students should arrive at Venado at 9:00 a.m. Students will also need to be signed out by parents at the end of the assembly, at approximately 10:00 a.m.

We really want to avoid doing this, so please submit <u>your requests by the deadline</u>.
