On Friday, April 25, teachers will also review this important information with students during Advisement. Elective classes are <u>not</u> assigned on a first come, first served basis. Once requests are submitted, changes are not permitted, so please take time to consider your requests carefully with your child. <u>Parents who do not submit elective course requests will have elective classes assigned to their students.</u> We really want to avoid doing this, so please submit your request by the deadline.
