Digital Photography/Graphic Art

- Previous enrollment in another art class is not required.



- Mediums may include graphite, charcoal, tempera and acrylic paint, watercolor, and clay.
- Students will also engage in developing academic literacy in the elements of art and principles of design, art history, careers, and criticism.
- Students with all levels of artistic skill are welcome to join this class to explore, experiment, and create an artistic voice.

Students enrolled in this elective will rotate and spend a trimester in each of the three classes: Intro to Art, Exploring Culinary Arts, & Sign Language.


Intro to Art



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
JAZZ ENSEMBLE



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


